## **Six people injured in Mandera bus attack**

**Friday, 1 July 2016, Nairobi:** Six people were injured when two buses were attacked today at a location between El Wak and Wargadud in Mandera County.

Among the six injured, three were critical and had to be evacuated by the Kenya Red Cross Society Emergency Medical Service (E-Plus) to Mandera District Hospital, while the other three were treated at a nearby health facility.

The two buses, belonging to E-Coach and Tawakal, had departed from El Wak and attacked by a suspected armed group. The Kenya Red Cross Society Mandera Branch, the E-Plus ambulance services and security forces responded quickly to the incident.
