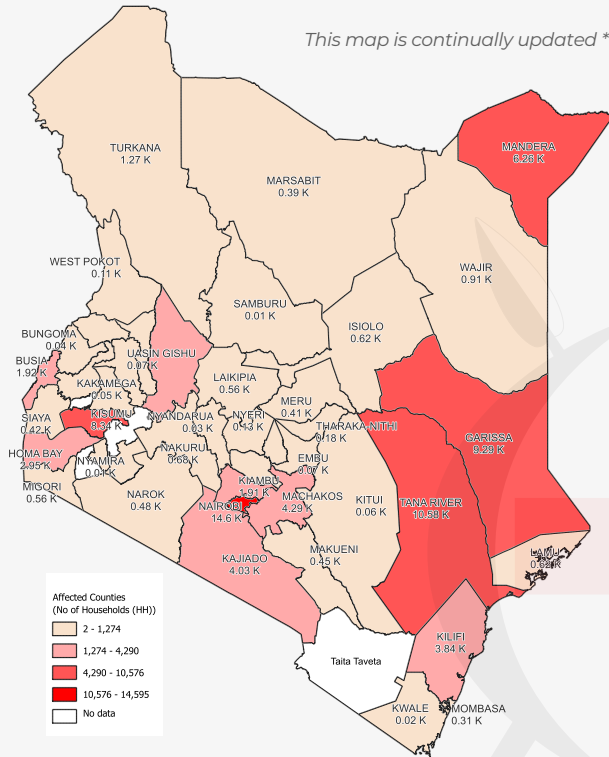


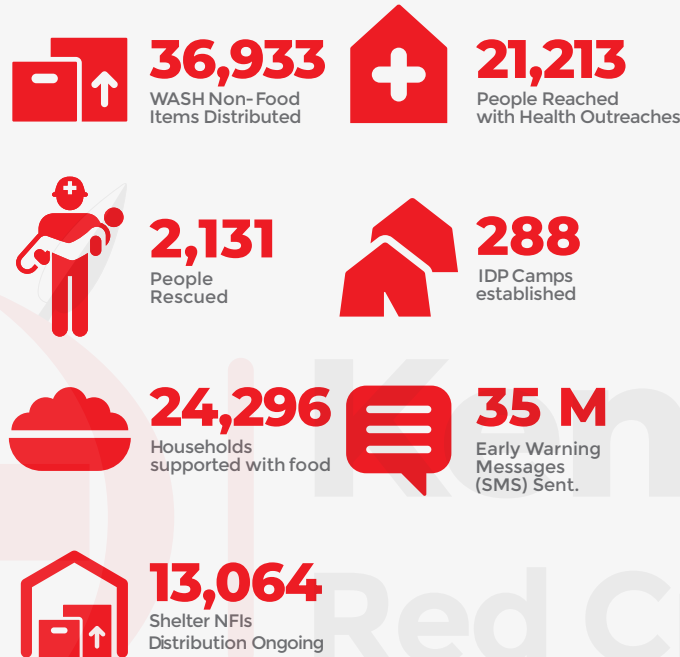

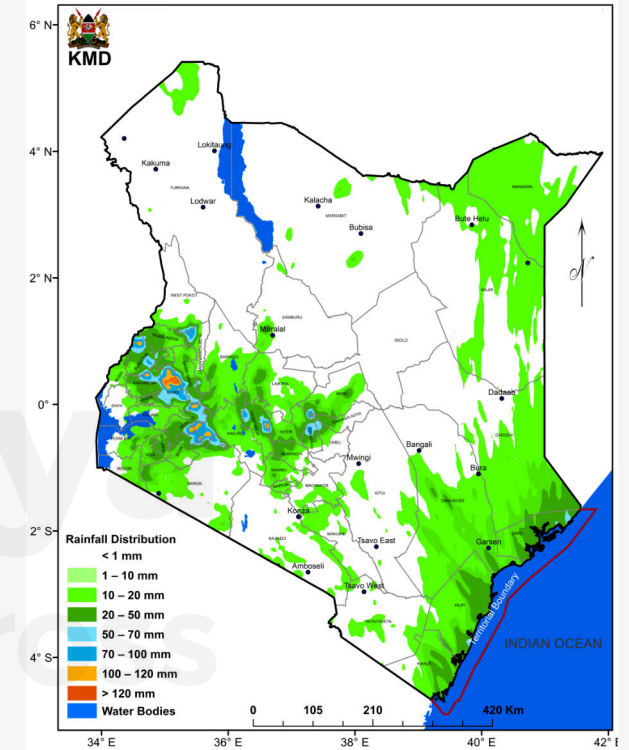
AFFECTED AREAS



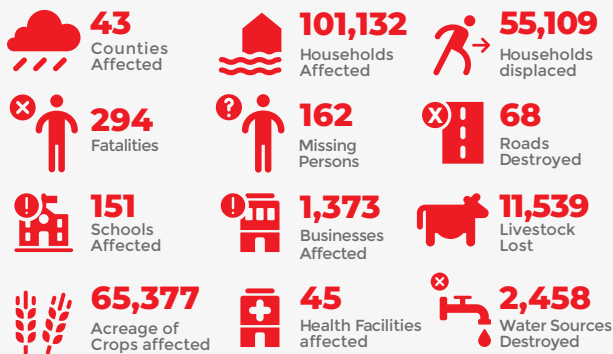
KENYA RED CROSS INTERVENTIONS

WHAT TO EXPECT

Dry weather conditions are predicted over several parts of the country. However, rainfall is expected in a few areas in the Highlands East and West of the Rift Valley, the Lake Victoria Basin, the Rift Valley, the coastal region, and some parts of northeastern Kenya. Intermittent cold and cloudy conditions are expected over some parts of the Highlands East and West of the Rift Valley, the southeastern lowlands, and the Rift Valley. Average night-time (minimum) temperatures will be low (less than 10°C) in some parts of the Highlands East of the Rift Valley and the Central Rift Valley. High average daytime (maximum) temperatures of more than 30°C will be experienced in some parts of the Coast, northeastern, and northwestern Kenya.
